THE CMC PROVIDES resources for elementary and secondary teacher education programs at The University of Southern Mississippi. Established in 1965 and located in Cook Library, the center is open to all university students, faculty and staff, as well as to the general public.

The CMC contains a collection of children and young adult literature and a wide variety of materials to support K-12 instruction. Resources for special education students are also available.

# CHILDREN'S BOOKS

The CMC is home to all of Cook Library's children's books. Copies of all Newbery and Caldecott winners are available, as well as a collection of popular children's books translated into Spanish, French and other languages.

### **IEXTBOOKS**

The Curriculum Materials Center is a depository for Mississippi state-adopted textbooks and makes available copies of the most recent textbooks that have been approved for use in K-12 schools in Mississippi. Arranged by subject area, publisher and grade level, the textbooks often have accompanying materials such as test booklets, teacher-resource guides, worksheets and CD-ROMs.

### **ACTIVITY BOOKS**

More than 1,000 activity and bulletin board design books are available in the CMC. Activity books can provide games, art ideas, quizzes, models, and other activities and ideas that can be used to supplement lesson plans or to plan units around particular themes.

#### KITS

Kits are collections of carefully organized multimedia materials designed to focus on a particular topic, unit or theme that may include teacher guides or other lesson-planning information. Most kits in the center are for use in grades K-8.

The Curriculum Materials Center has an assortment of realia, or objects that can be used in teaching. Puppets, puzzles and globes are just a few of the items in this collection.
